
Info tab in FlashPoints.

In earlier versions, you had to go to the Settings screen and check the boxes of the items you wanted to have appear on your drawings. FlashPoints would then print them for you whether they contained data or not.

This has been changed. Now you can just type information in the fields you want to on the Job Info tab and FlashPoints will only print the items that have information in them. Empty fields will be ignored, automatically.

## **New Improved Automatic Placement**

Automatic Placement now places appliances under the hood automatically from LEFT to RIGHT. We have had a lot of requests to reverse how it was working. But we also found that LEFT to RIGHT works better. Appliances that are placed under the hood and are resized or changed maintain their position on the LEFT and grow or shrink on the RIGHT. So there is no need to realign the appliance after it is changed. This is a huge time savings!

## A Disclaimer for Stamps



PDF Converter.

Add a Stamp Note to your cover pages if your AHJ requires an engineers stamp on your pre-engineered system drawings. Simply check the Stamp Note box when you setup the cover page and FlashPoints will print the following note at the bottom of the cover page:

Any engineer stamps affixed to these drawings are to satisfy AHJ requirements, only, and do not change the status of the system from "pre-engineered" to "engineered", as the design and installation remain within the manufacturer specified parameters.
